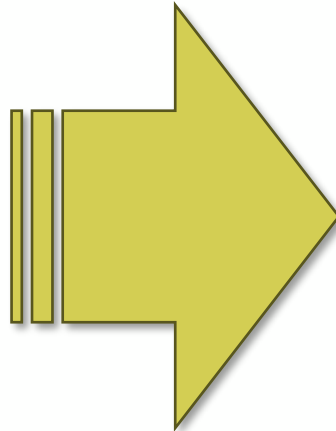
# Technical Workshop

- Delivered virtually in 24 October 2024
- Invitations to EuroGeographics members, relevant and interested stakeholders, researchers and software suppliers
- Call for papers early July – requesting papers on specific themes for each topic area
  - Harmonisation - aim to facilitate a discussion about the challenges on making harmonisation work and presentations from the OME2 project.
  - Edge-matching – aim to request examples on how edge-matching is done at national scale, including examples of EuroGeographics work on pan European datasets and OME2 tools.
