

EuroGeographics membership activities are underpinned by the principle of enabling access to members' data – and the value of data is in its use.






OME2: A foundation for future pan-European high-value datasets

- Proves EuroGeographics and its members can deliver large-scale edgematched data.

- Demonstrates demand for edge-matched data with higher-than-expected user numbers.
- Enhances Open Cadastral Map and establishes a vision for the future.
- Strengthens relevance and credibility of EuroGeographics and its members with key stakeholders.

 - Hydrography


Coverage

- Initially for EU27 + CH
 - TRANS / HYDRO may only be EU25 + CH

If more funding became available the production schedule could be reviewed and extended within the three-year period, EU27 is linked to the short-term value proposition

Cadastral Data

- Vision: the Open Cadastral Map becomes a single point to easily find and access authoritative information
- OME2 project aim to develop a pan-European Cadastral Data Strategy
- The outcomes of the OME2 Project will be considered by EuroGeographics and an appropriate way forward agreed for the Open Cadastral Map with our members


