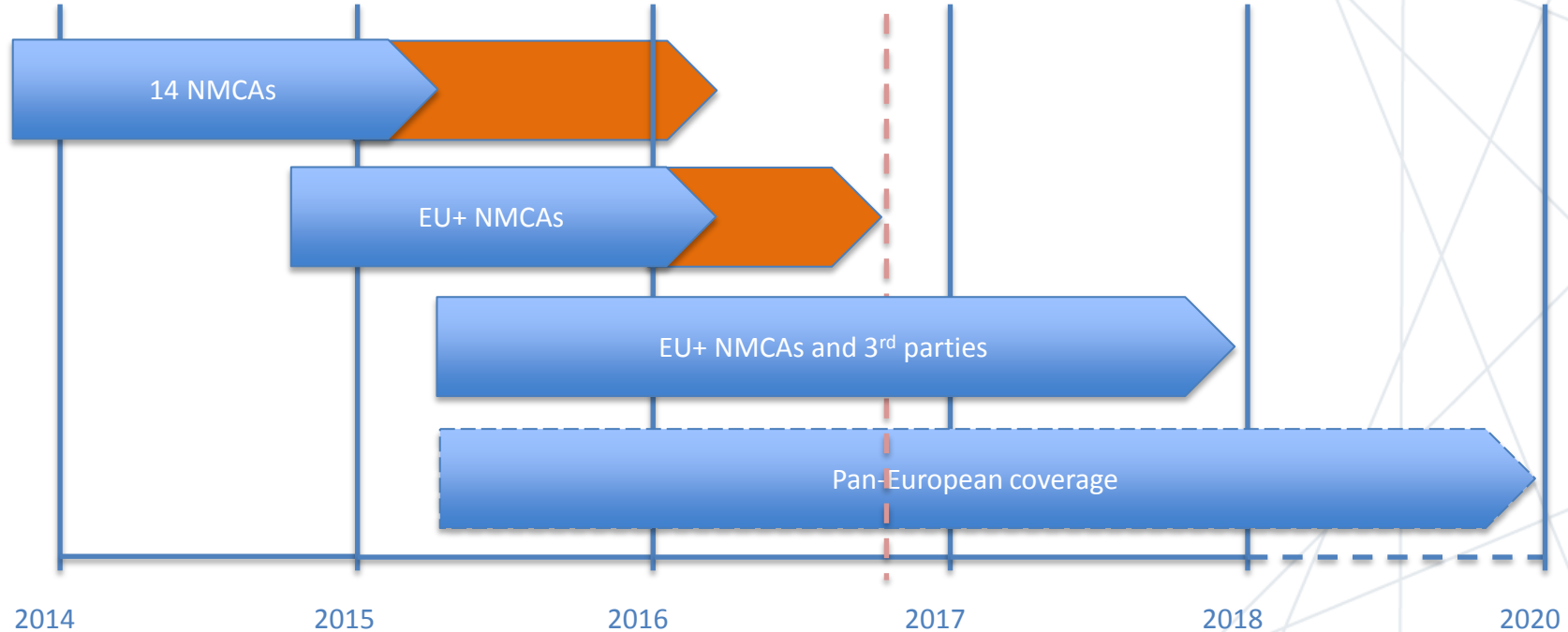


Coverage of ELF data contributions



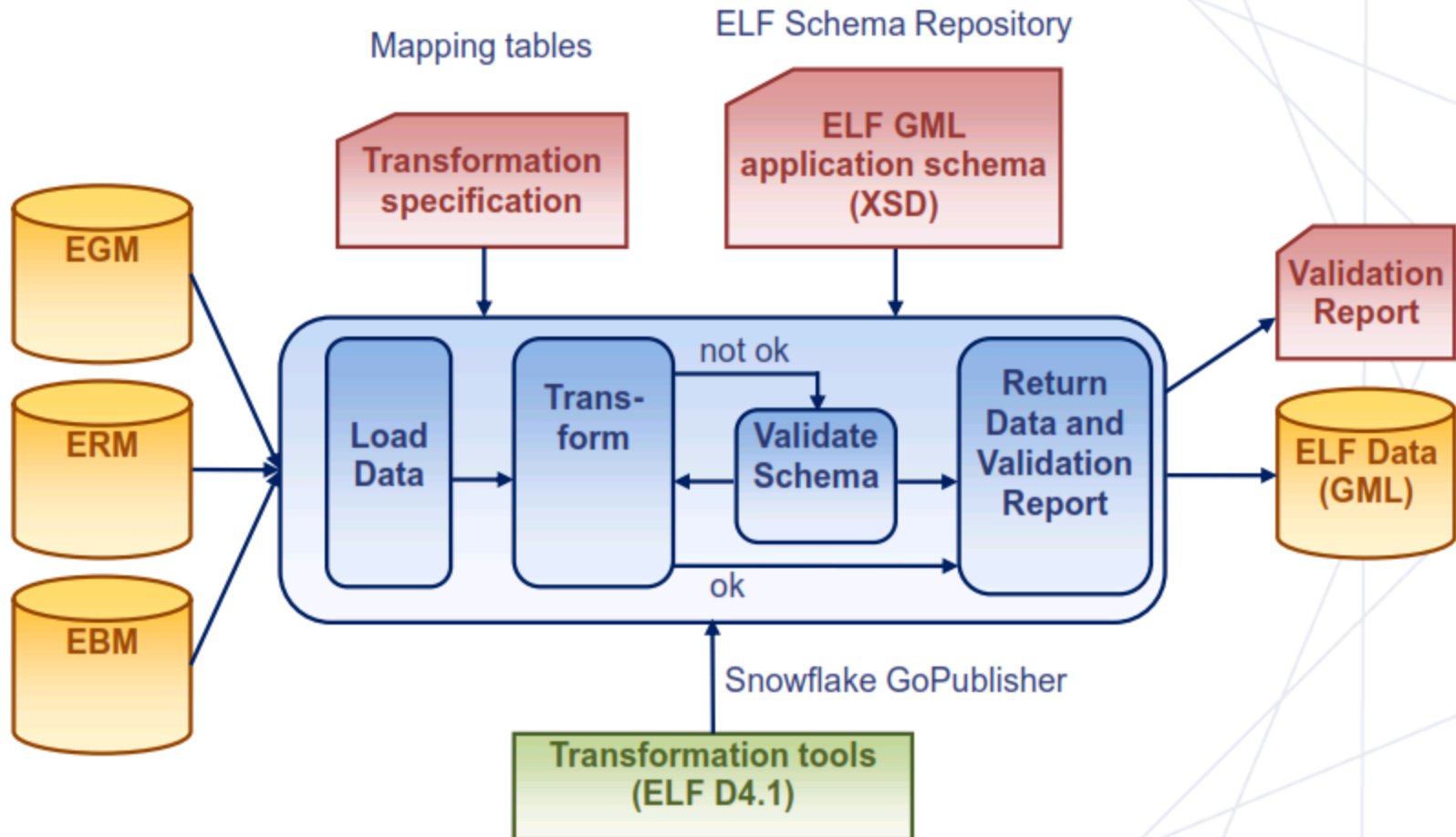

The roadmap to a full ELF European coverage



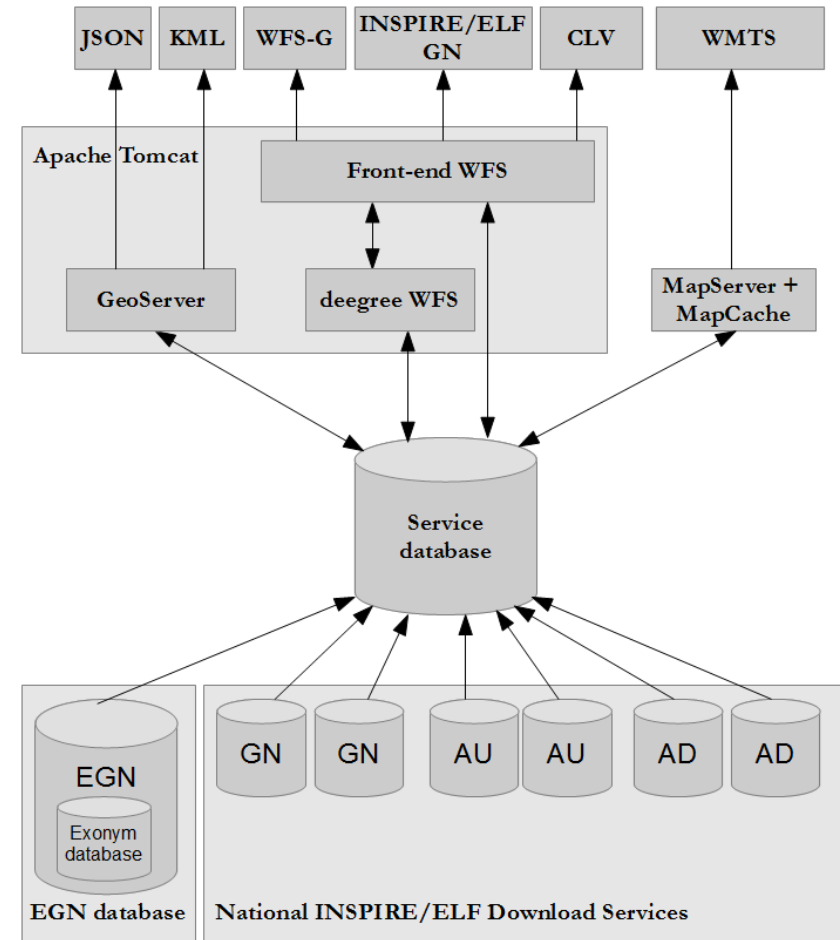

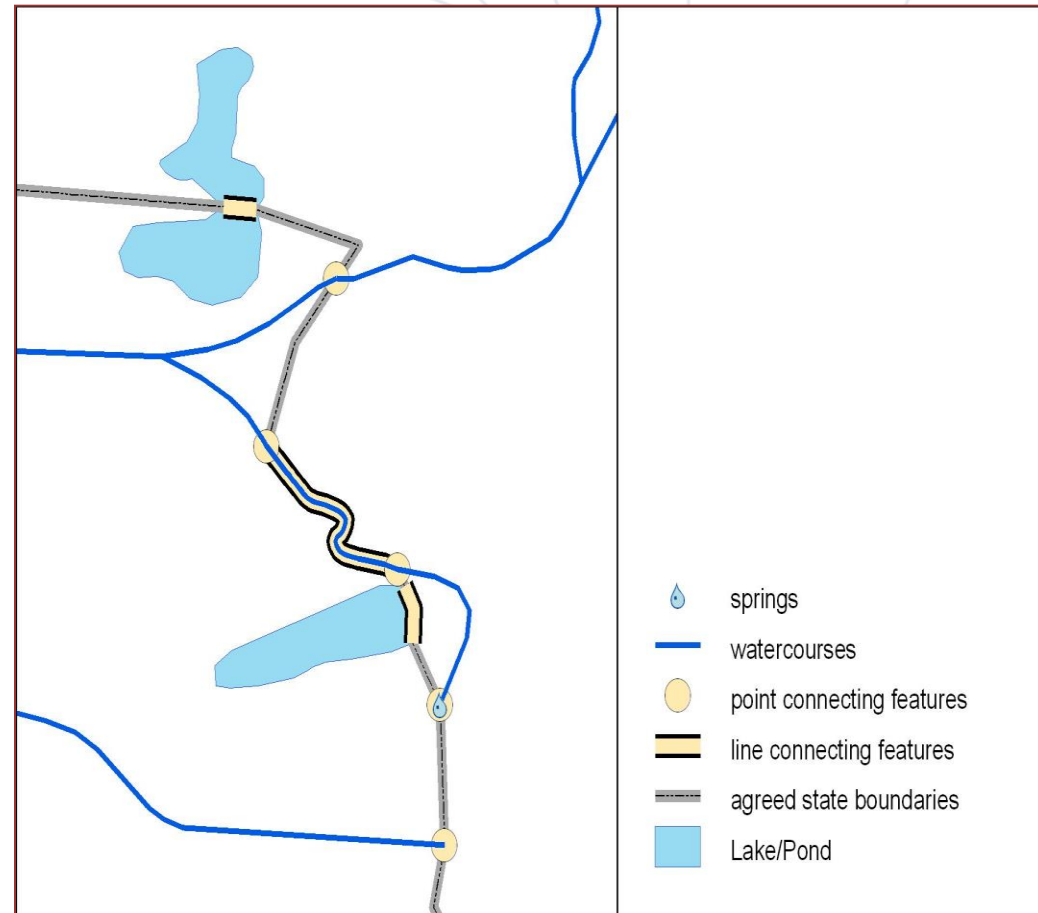


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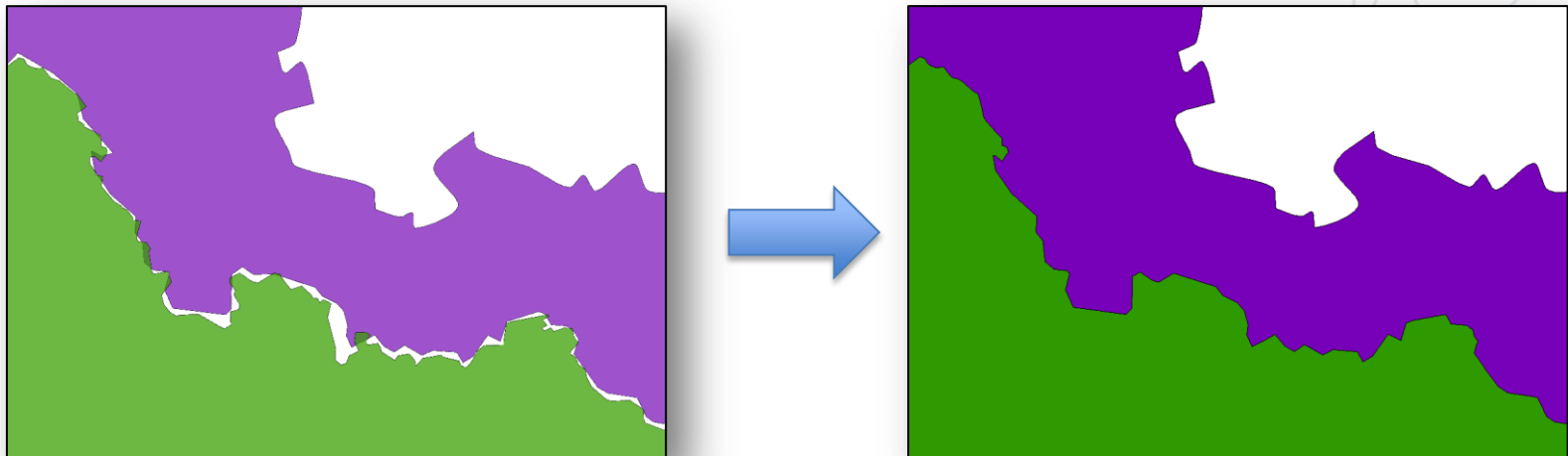
ELF ~~International Boundaries~~ lines of connecting features

- ★ Agreed lines/points of connecting features
- ★ Connecting features
 - ★ Locations on the lines where edge matched geographic entities from neighbouring countries connect
 - ★ Serve as anchor for repeatable edge matching
- ★ Defined for all LoD

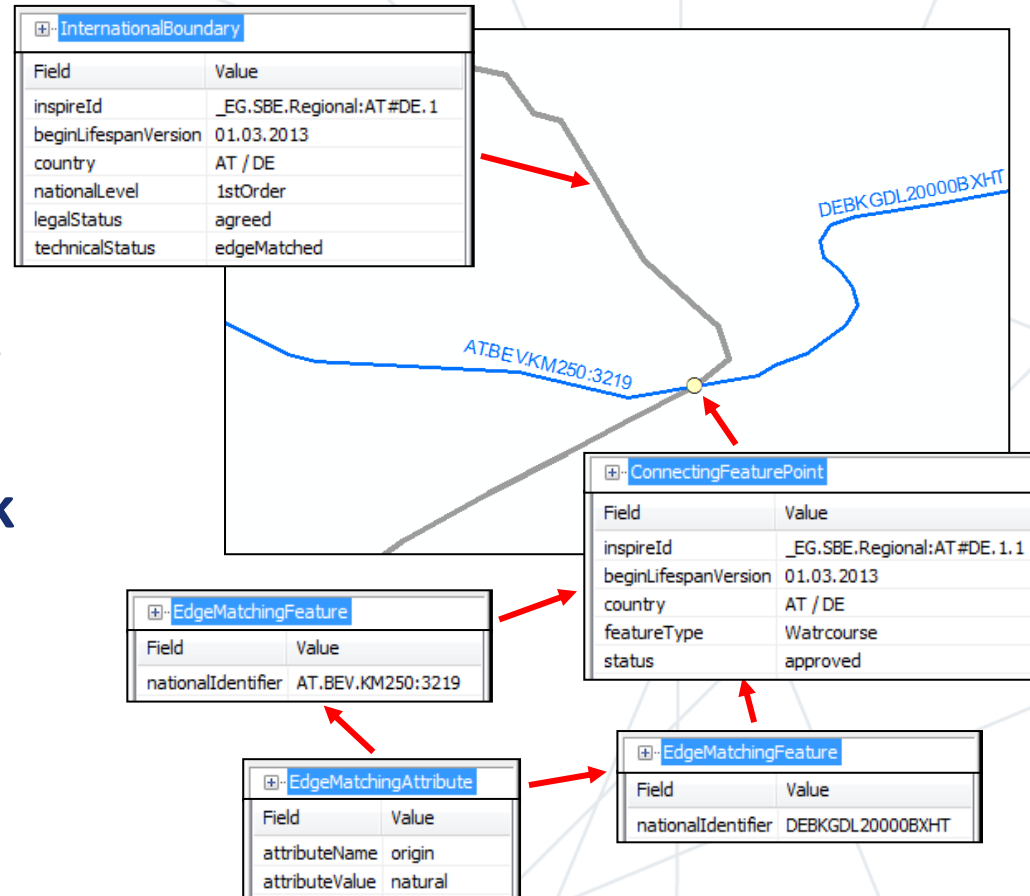


Edge Matching tools

- ★ Based on ELF specifications delivered by WP 2
- ★ Delft University has developed Pprepair for edge matching functionality on polygons
- ★ 1spatial has developed the tool 1Integrate.
- ★ Esri has configured their ArcGIS Datareviewer edge matching functionalities



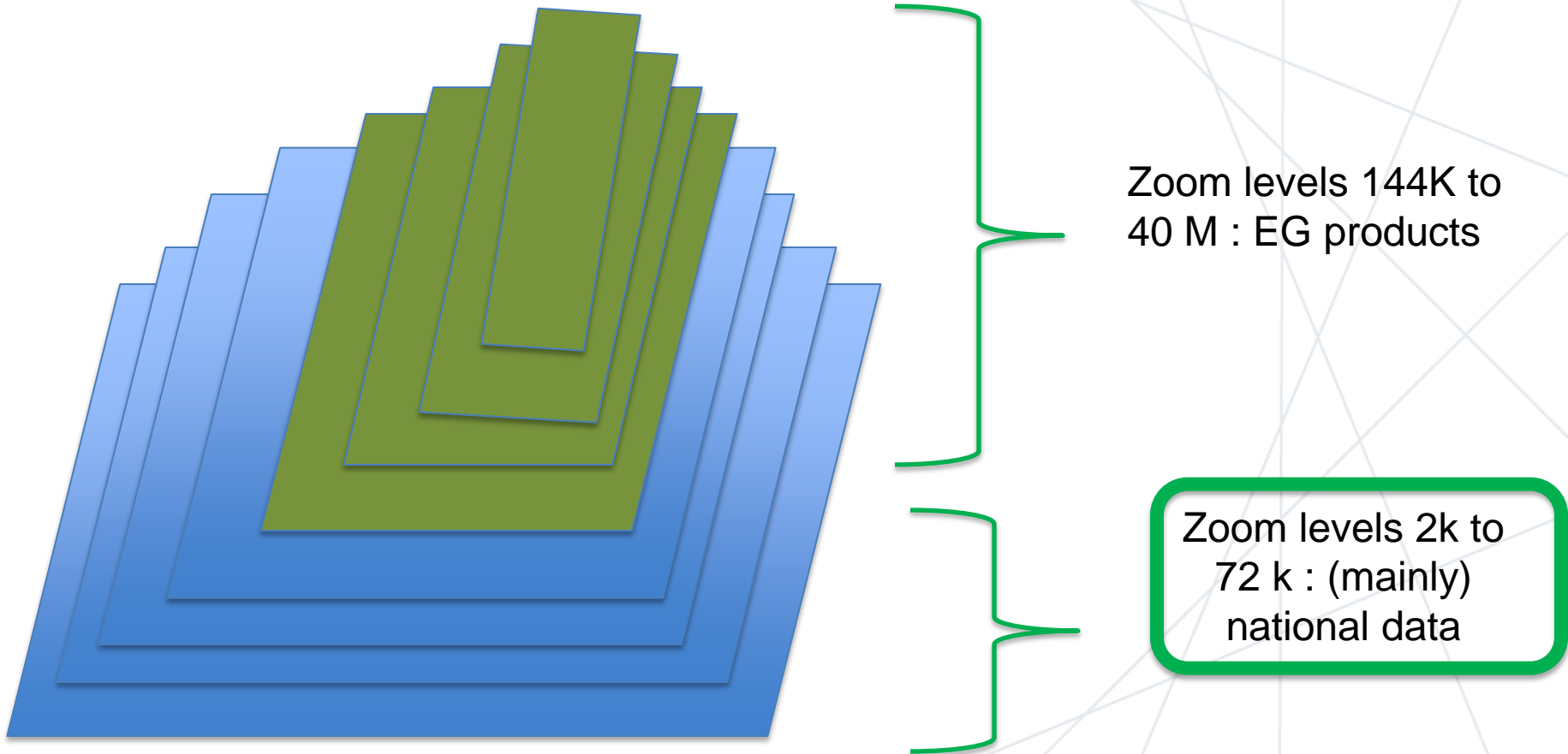

ELF BaseMap

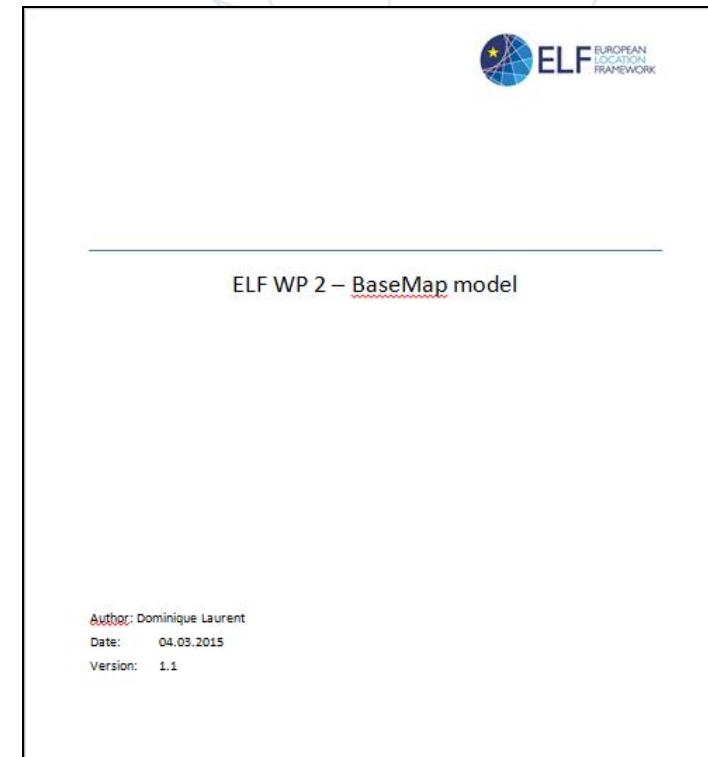
- ★ **BaseMap is a pyramid of digital maps displaying ELF base data, at different levels of zoom**
- ★ **WMTS service**
 - ★ Content : themes AU, BU, LC, HY, TN and GN (EL to be added later)
 - ★ Themes AD and CP to be dealt by ELF Cadastre
- ★ **Geographic extend : geographic Europe (oversea territories excluded)**
- ★ **Main use cases**
 - ★ Consultation
 - ★ Background map for applications
- ★ **CRS: pseudo Mercator (3857) and LAEA (3035)**
- ★ **Levels of zoom : from a standardized list**
 - ★ From 2d to 40M

Methodology



BaseMap data model

- **Provides**
 - ★ BaseMap simple data model itself
 - ★ Matching guidelines from ELF data model to BaseMap
- **Makes NMCAs aware of the expected content of BaseMap**
 - ★ Feature types
 - ★ Attributes to be used for
 - Selection criteria (generalisation)
 - Different symbols

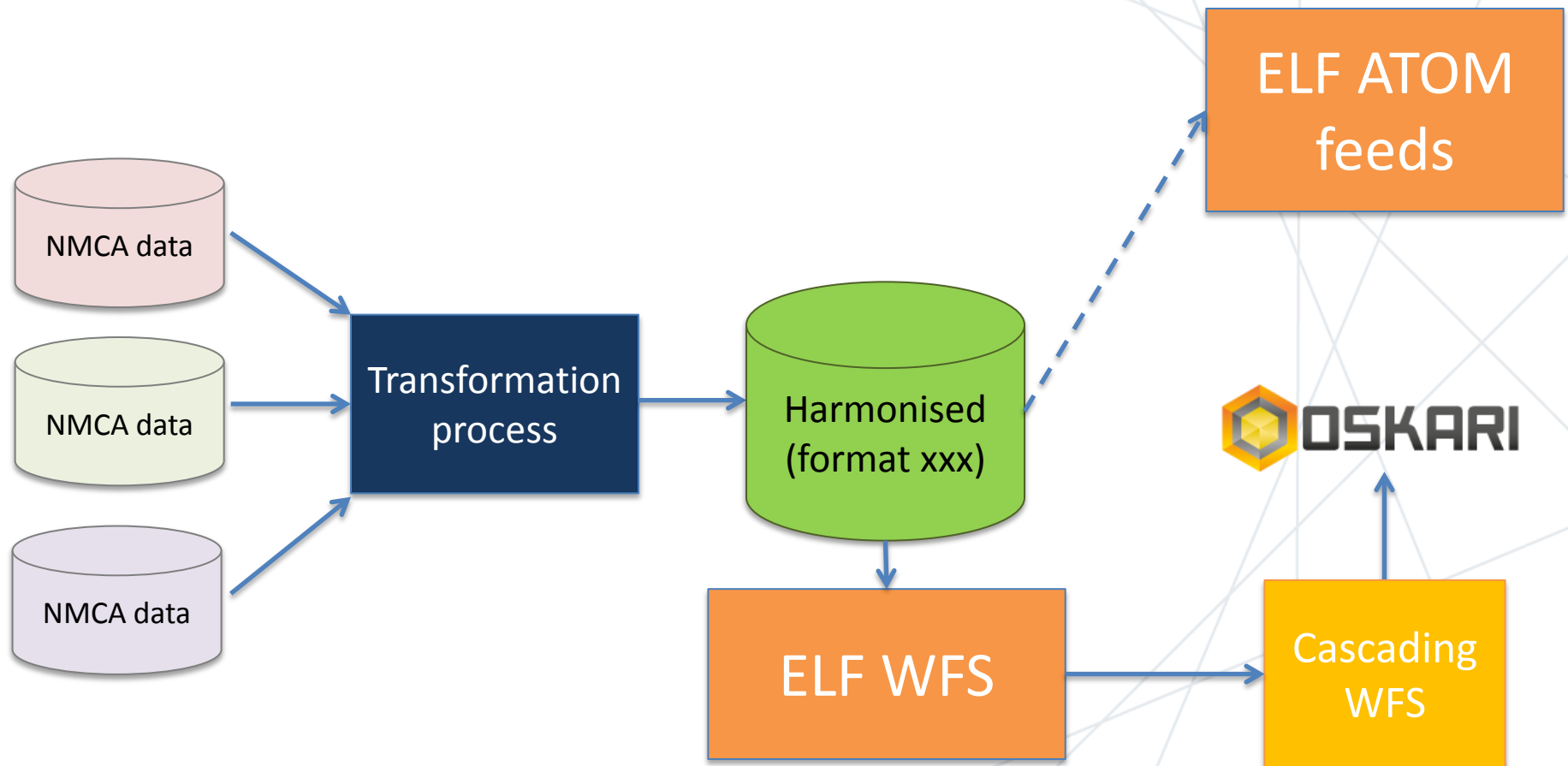


SLD (Style Layer Descripton)

- Standardised way to document portrayal rules
- Provides
 - ★ Layer name
 - ★ Layer source : feature type + OGC filter if relevant
 - ★ Scale range
 - ★ Symbol to be applied

Source data for ELF download services: transform existing data to ELF/INSPIRE data model (recommended option)



- ★ Should be conformant to INSPIRE network services, follow Technical guidelines
 - ★ Download services
 - ★ View services – not required but, relatively easy to setup
- ★ Must support the two projections
 - ★ EPSG 3857(Web Mercator) and EPSG 3035(ETRS-LAEA)
- ★ ELF National services must be well documented:
 - ★ Metadata according to INSPIRE. Discovery service and Metadata IR
 - ★ Capabilities file. INSPIRE Technical Guidance
- ★ WFS direct access strongly recommended
 - ★ WFS 2.0.0, GML 3.2.1
 - ★ Optional Atom feeds as supplement to WFSs
- ★ Data should be harmonized. Edge matched, quality controlled Use/validate vs. the ELF application schemas www.locationframework.eu/schemas



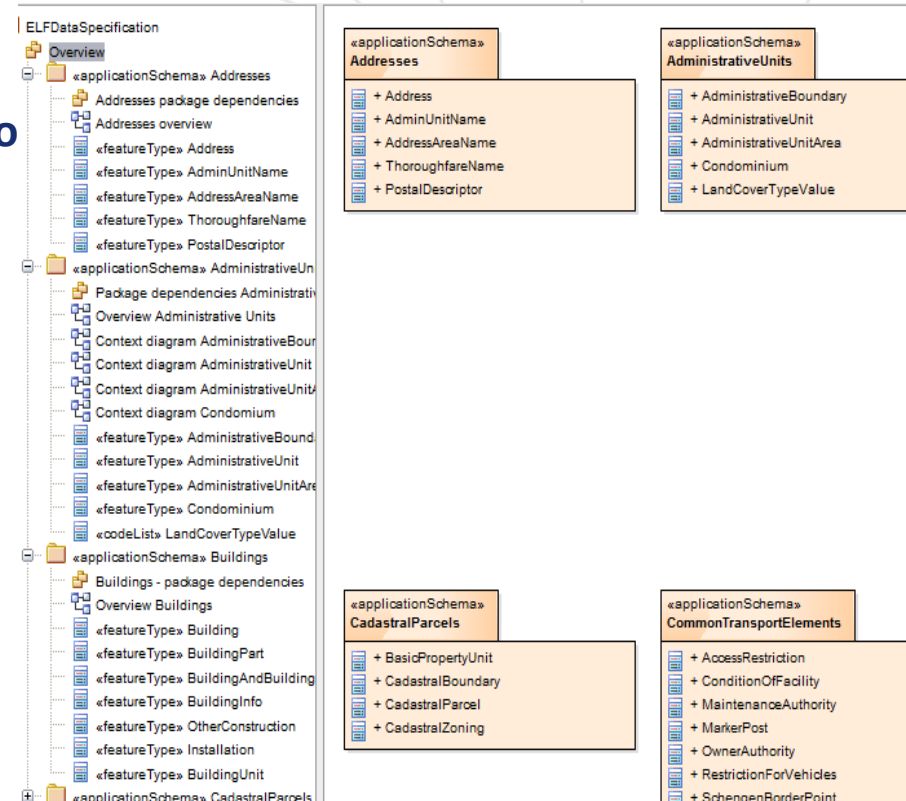

Using ELF geo-tools, the datasets are prepared by the NMCAs to conform to the applicable ELF data and product specifications.

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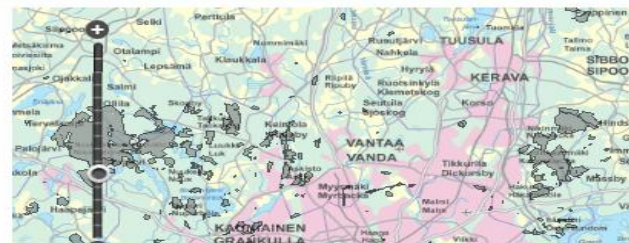
