2030 policy programme 'Path to the Digital Decade' adopted

This week the Council adopted the 2030 policy programme 'Path to the Digital Decade', which ensures that the EU meets its objectives for a digital transformation in line with EU values. The decision The Council: aims to strengthen the EU's digital leadership by promoting inclusive and sustainable digital policies that serve citizens and businesses. To this end, it sets out the concrete digital targets that the EU and its member states aim to reach by the end of the decade in four areas: strengthening digital skills and education; secure and sustainable digital infrastructures; digital transformation of businesses; digitalisation of public services. The policy programme will facilitate investments in areas like highperformance computing, common data infrastructure and services, blockchain, low-power processors, pan-European development of 5G corridors, high-tech partnership for digital skills, secure quantum infrastructure and network of cybersecurity centres, digital public administration, testing facilities and digital innovation hubs. The decision also provides for an effective cooperation mechanism between the Member States and the Commission with a view to achieving the programme's objectives. The text of the decision will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union in the coming days and will enter into force the twentieth day after this publication. "We need a coherent database, and we need data that we can trust and rely on. We need authoritative geospatial information, quality controlled, preferably from governmental sources with borders and boundaries that should reflect the EU view. We also need a common place where we can do planning. So, the 1:250 000 scale seamless open data is crucial for us in determining, for example, where we reinforce our bridges so that Lieutenant-Colonel Soenke Fischhoefer, Senior Geospatial Officer EUMS, EU External Action Service.
