
We continue to be registered on the EU Transparency Register and are bound by its code of conduct.


Connecting Members to European Policy




European geospatial information from official sources

EuroGeographics offers four European geospatial data products. Each is produced using official geospatial data from our members, the National Mapping, Cadastre and Land Registry Authorities.

Our products are harmonised to standard specifications, so users can be confident that the information provided is consistent, comparable and easily shared – regardless of its national source. The data is updated annually and can be used in a wide range of applications including analysis, planning and research.

We offer standardised, transparent pricing and licensing link to licences> agreements, including an open data link> licence for our 1:1 million scale European topographic dataset, EuroGlobalMap. EuroBoundaryMap is a seamless geo-database at the scale 1:100 000 covering 55 countries (according to ISO country code and Kosovo) from 39 data producers. It contains geometry, names and codes of administrative and statistical units continuously updated by our members, the national mapping and cadastral authorities (NMCAs) of Europe. It links to the updated statistical LAU- and NUTS-codes for all local administrative units of the 28 member states of the European Union.





Database structure	The geometry of administrative units at most detailed level is stored in a data layer. The boundaries, administrative units on upper hierarchical level and statistical regions are provided as additional layers. Attributive information is stored in linked tables.


