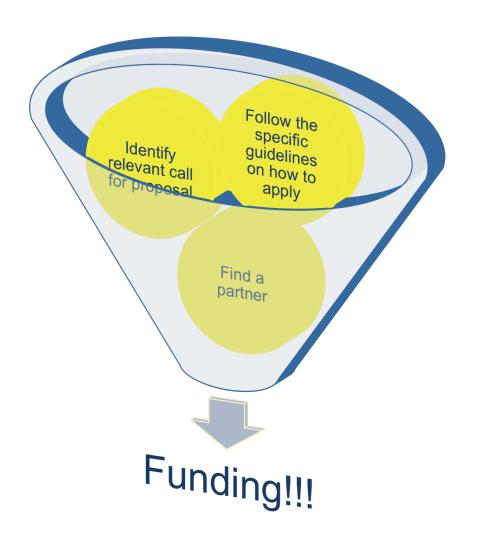

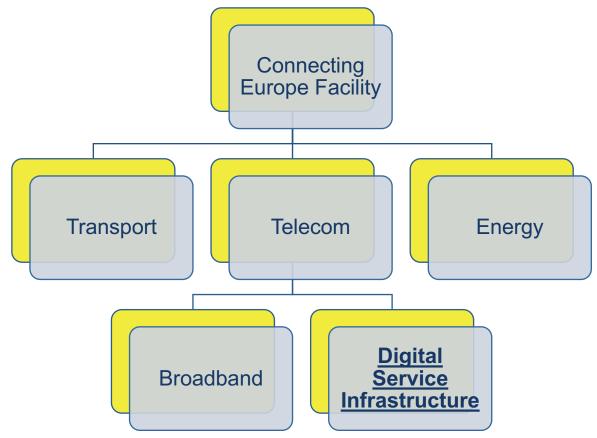

CEF Telecom - key EU instrument to facilitate cross-border interaction between public administrations, businesses and citizens







Common Agricultural Policy (CAP) - original pillars and one of the most important EU common policies integrating environmental concerns



If engaged in farming, a public body may be eligible for a direct payment under the European Agricultural Guarantee Fund (EAGF)





## Cohesion policy



delivered through two main funds: the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF) and the Cohesion Fund (CF) and the European Social Fund (ESF). Together with the European Social Fund (ESF), the European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development (EAFRD) and the European Maritime and Fisheries Fund (EMFF), they make up the European Structural and Investment (ESI) Funds

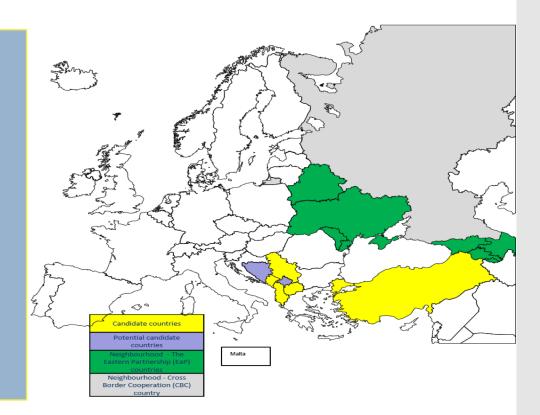
