- Provision of EBM v12 (NUTS 2013) and ERM v11.1 to data producers and public

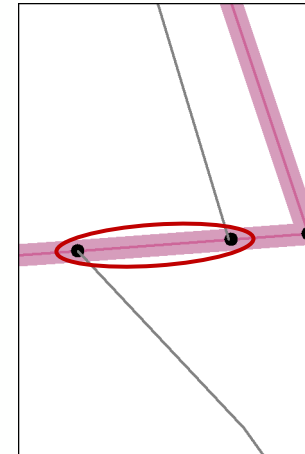
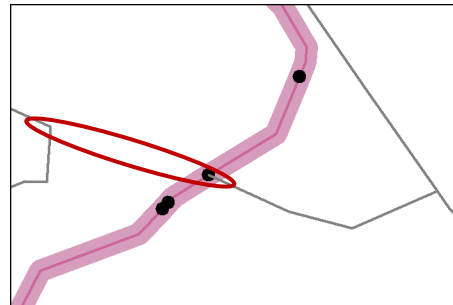
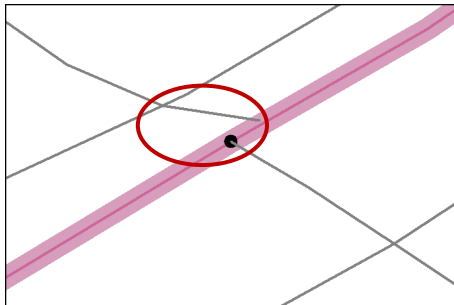

 - Hints for edge matching of transport theme were sent to data producers in April



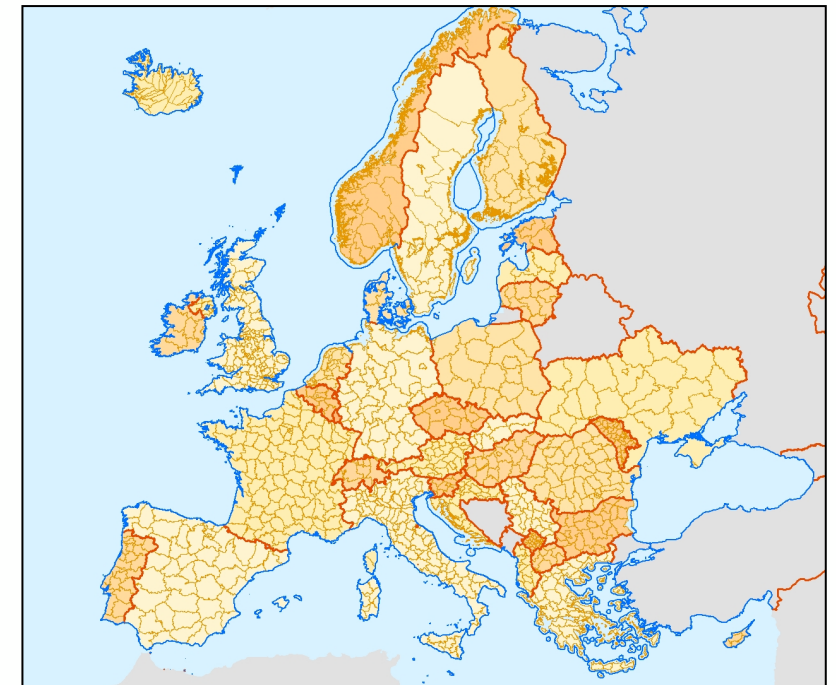

EuroBoundaryMap

- Up-to-date geometry, names and codes of all administrative units for 41 European countries
- Derived LAU- and NUTS regions based on the linkage to the statistical codes used by National Statistics Institutes and Eurostat
- Yearly update
- Reference date for EBM v13: 01.01.2018
- Product managed by BKG



EuroBoundaryMap - Statistical data

- Correct matching with statistical codes is a main feature of EBM
- Ensure that National Statistical Institute (NSI) and National Mapping and Cadastral Agencies (NMCA) report the same administrative units for the specific reference date
→ EBM will only match with statistical data if both refer to same reference date
- Changes:
 - New NUTS 2016 regulation
 - Only one LAU level instead of two levels
→ Simplifies matching

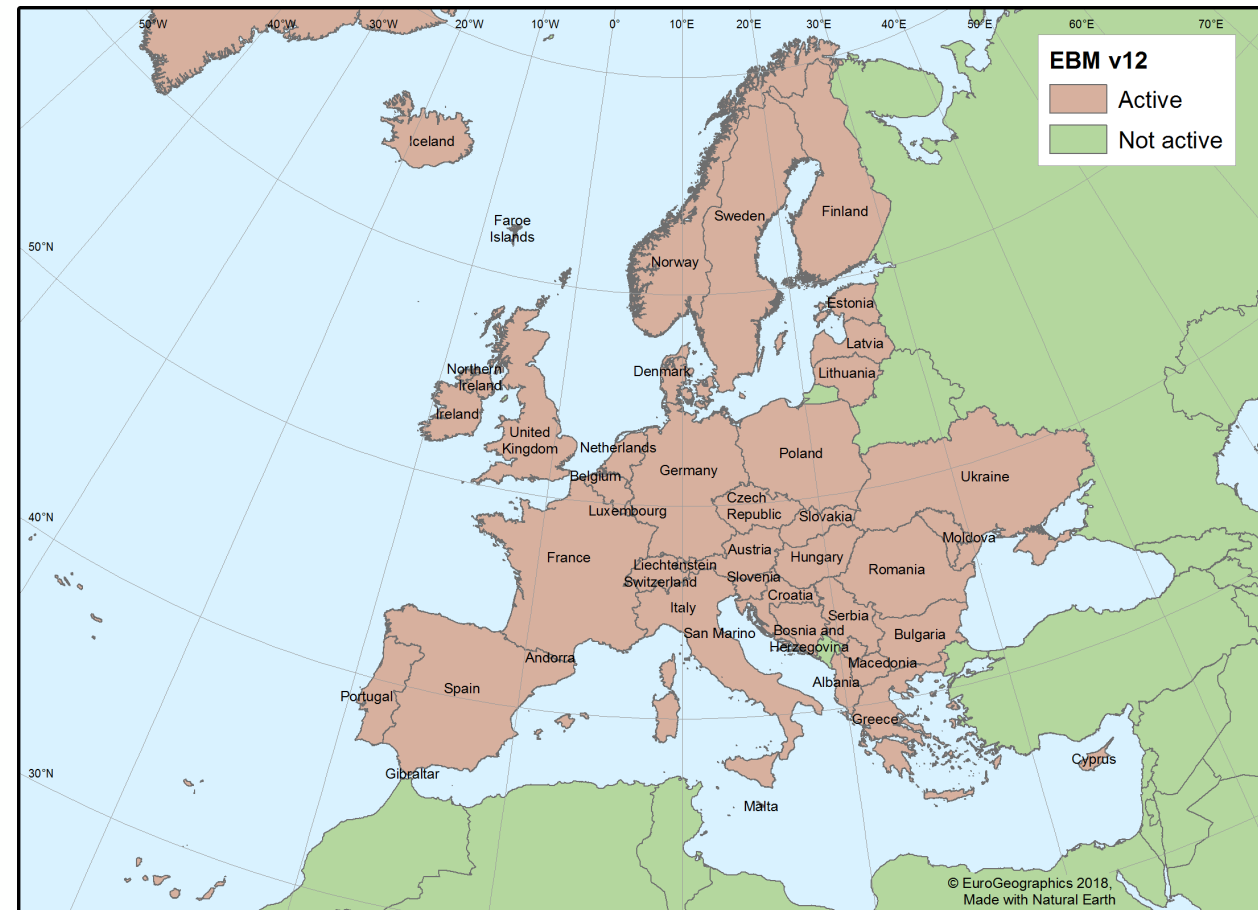

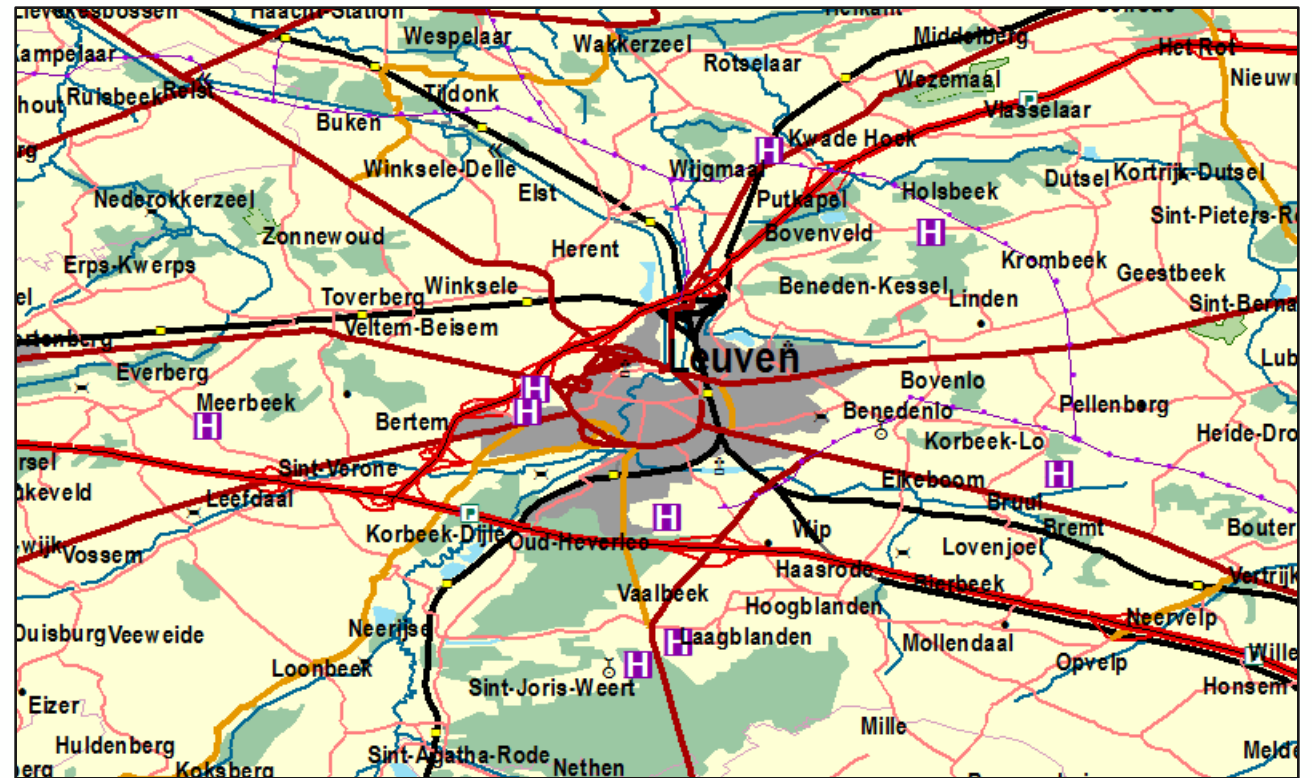
EuroBoundaryMap - Coverage

 - Montenegro
 - Georgia (legislative issues)



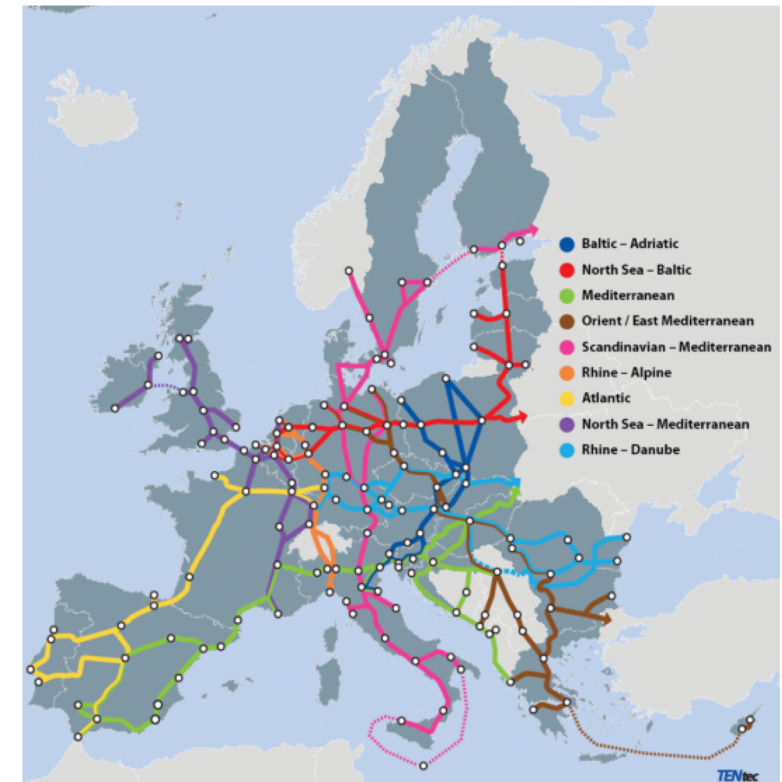
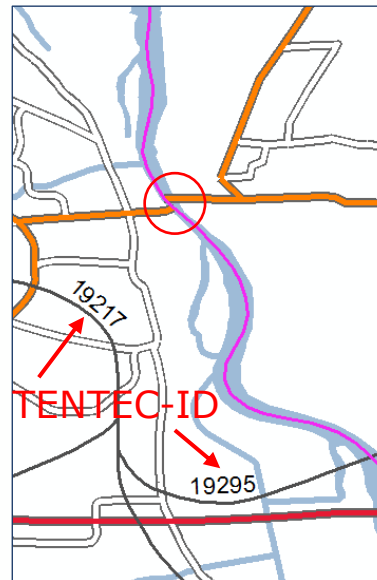
EuroRegionalMap

- Topographic dataset 1:250,000
- Themes
 - Administrative Boundaries (BND)
 - Hydrography (HYDRO)
 - Miscellaneous (MISC)
 - Named Location (NAME)
 - Settlement (POP)
 - Transportation (TRANS)
 - Vegetation and Soils (VEG)
- Yearly update:
2-3 themes according to the
contract with Eurostat (until 2018)
- Product managed by BKG



EuroRegionalMap

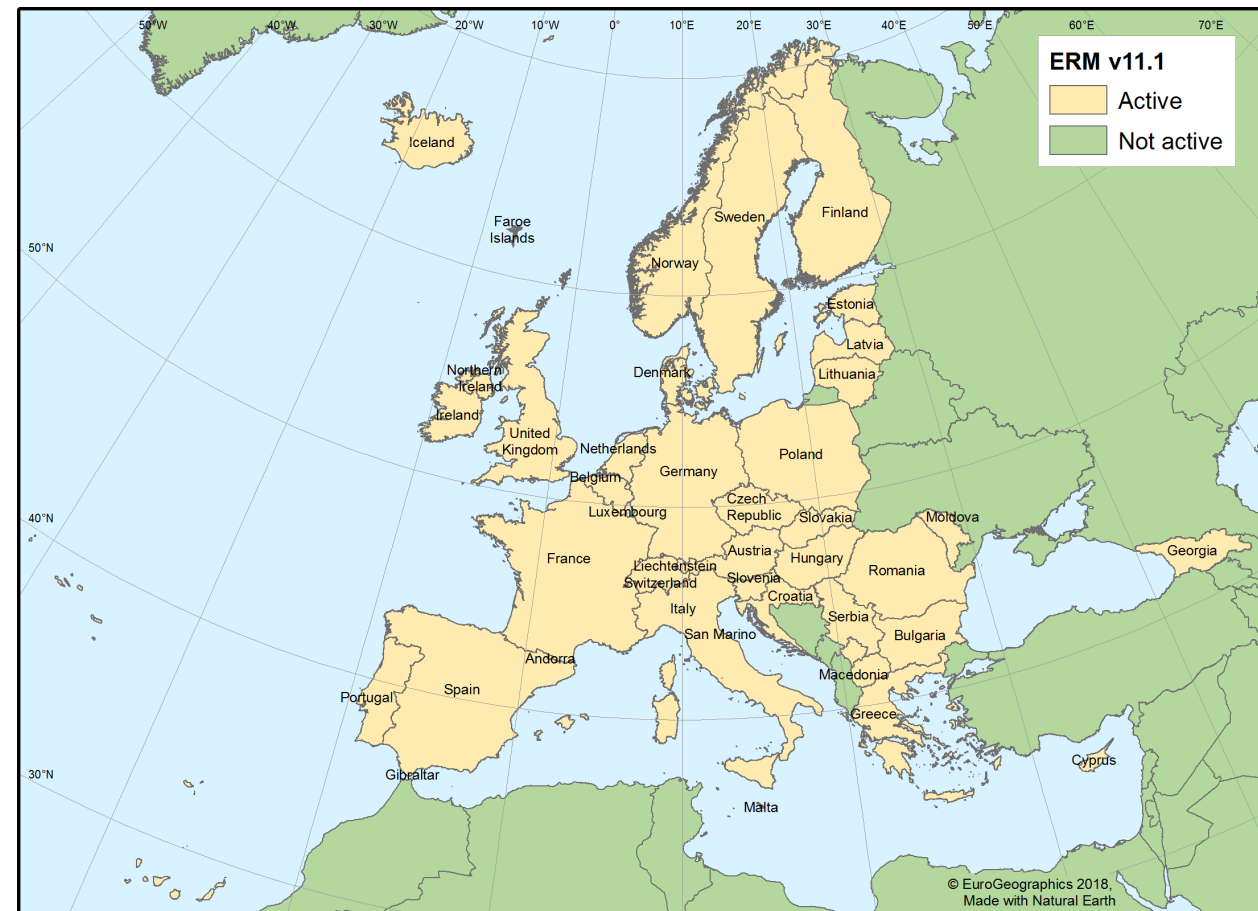
- Changes in data specification and data model for ERM v12 (TEN, TENTEC-ID)
- Update BND: Consistency with EBM update
- Real update: TRANS, POP, VEG
- Maintain TEN-T network
- ERM Master dataset with features located on international boundary
→ Improve edge matching



Note: the nine TEN-T core network corridors are based on the CEF and TEN-T Regulations (1315/2013 & 1315/2013); they have been created as a coordination instrument to facilitate the completion of major parts of the core network of strategic importance.

 - Turkey

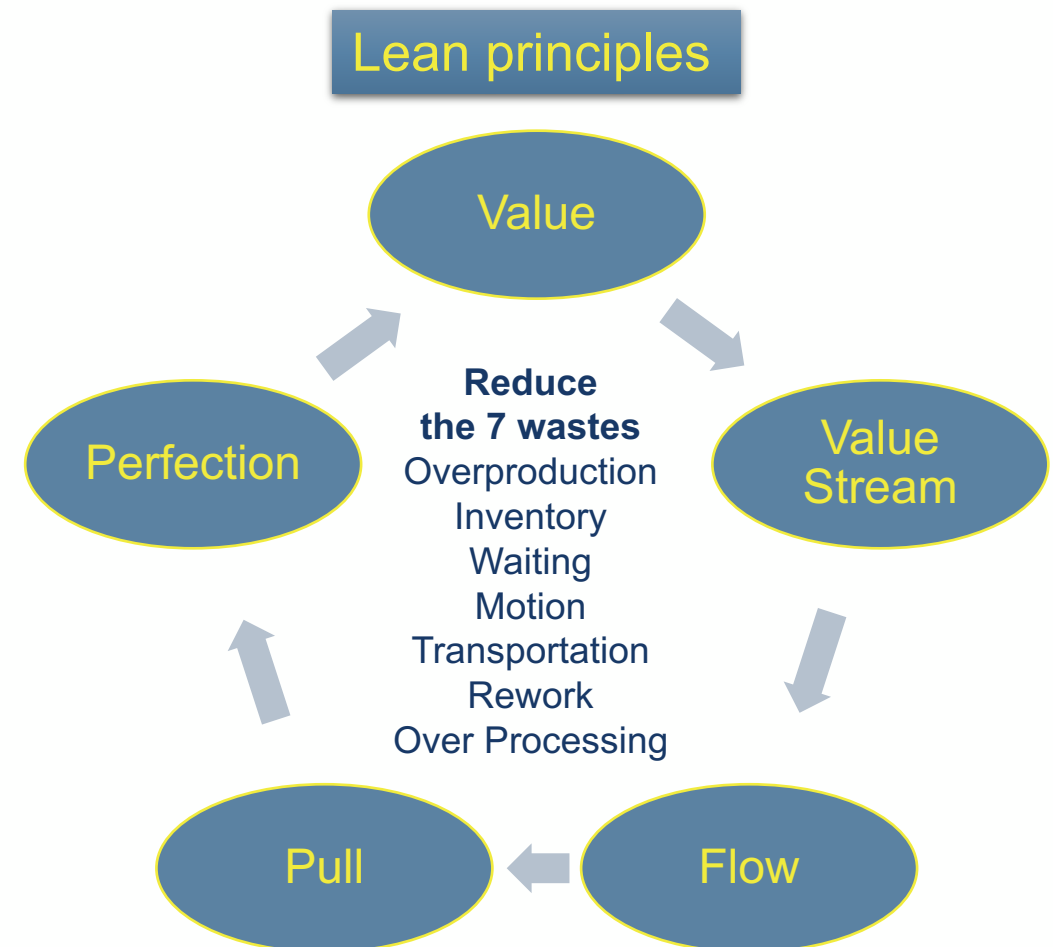


Quality Management

- Responsibility: Kadaster Netherlands

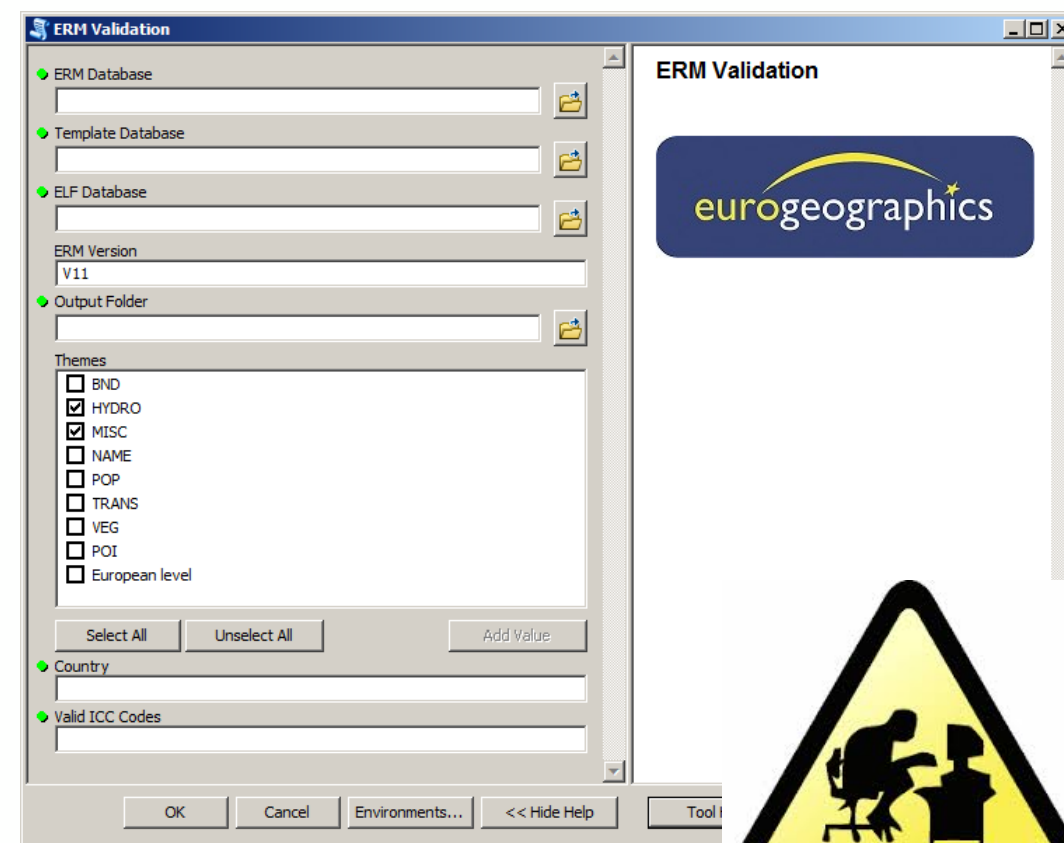


- Approach
 - Close cooperation with data producers
 - Consideration of Lean principles
 - Tool based on Python validation tools by IGN-F



Quality Management

- Objectives of the new quality management tool
 - One tool approach
 - Users: Producers, RCs, PMT
 - ArcGIS versions >10.1
 - Easy to use
 - Simple documentation
 - Stand alone desktop
 - ArcMap Standard and Advanced supported
- Latest release sent out in beginning of May 2018: Hydro and Trans checks available



Outlook

- Future of EBM and ERM depending on:
 - Willingness and resources of EuroGeographics and its members to produce the data products
 - Sufficient number of customers/users → New Eurostat contract?
- General ideas for EBM and ERM:
 - Streamline production
 - Create more synergies between ERM and EBM → Harmonise lineage files
 - Improve quality management
 - Coverage extension
 - Implementation of Inspire-ID for ERM
