

WP 9 meeting 1-2nd December 2015

Venue: Holmenkollen Park Hotel, Oslo

1 Timetable and agenda

The meeting is combined with an EG BiKEN meeting, which starts early Tuesday morning. The participants in EG BiKEN is expected to arrive Monday night.

The WP 9 part is planned to start midday on Tuesday 1st with a joint session with EG BiKEN and end around 3 PM on Wednesday 2nd. More detailed timetable and agenda will follow.

2 Venue

The venue is Holmenkollen Park Hotel, Oslo.

This is a venerable institution in Oslo, originally built as a sanatorium for tuberculosis patients in 1894 in the then hugely popular “dragon” style. When the nearby hotel burned down in 1914, the sanatorium became a hotel. Today it is a modern conference hotel, 350 meters above Oslo city centre, with fabulous views of the Norwegian capital and the fjord beyond.



It is close to the city forests many skiing and cycle trails, as well as attractions such as the Holmenkollen Ski Jump and the Ski Museum. The meeting room is in the old listed wooden building, while accommodation is in the newer parts of the hotel.

3 Accommodation and meals

As there are no alternative options in the area, it is suggested that people stay at the venue hotel. We will be organising the rooms with the hotel. The prices are:

Kartverket covers lunches and the dinner on Tuesday. We are planning an excursion in combination with the Tuesday dinner.

For those arriving Monday, we will organise a dinner at the hotel. If someone is staying until Thursday, we could organise a dinner on Wednesday as well, at the hotel or downtown.

4 Travel options

The nearest airport is Oslo Gardermoen. <https://avinor.no/en/airport/oslo-airport/>

It is 20 minutes by airport train to Oslo Center. More on transport to and from hotel here:

There are two other airports calling themselves Oslo, but be advised that these are at least a 90 minutes bus travel away from Oslo centre.

The fastest way to the hotel by public transport is to take the airport train to Oslo Central Station, and take *metro no. 1 Frognersesteren*, to the stop **Holmenkollen**. From there, it is 10 minutes' walk.



The reason why 700 meter takes 10 minutes is that it is mostly uphill.

You can also take taxi from the station, or directly from the airport. From the airport it is considerably cheaper if you order a taxi in advance (pre-order price approx. NOK 600 for a taxi for up to 4 people). From the Central Station to the hotel, an ordinary taxi ride (not pre-ordered) will be between NOK 300 and 450 depending on time of the day.

We will make a list of participants with time of arrival and departure, so you can organize yourselves to take taxi together if you like.
