



EuroBoundaryMap (EBM) overview

- Up-to-date geometry, names and codes of all administrative units for 41 European countries
- Derived LAU- and NUTS regions based on the linkage to the statistical codes used by National Statistics Institutes and Eurostat
- Yearly update
- Product managed by BKG





EBM v10

- Current version referring to 1.1.2015
- Product distributed to:
 - Eurostat in January 2016
 - Customers/VARs in March 2016
- Improvements:
 - Integration of inspireId
 - Common geometry EBM/ERM for a lot of countries
 - Country dataset of Albania and part of Bosnia and Herzegovina















EBM matching with statistical data


Married couples, by NUTS level 3 region, 2011

- Update cycle started
- Reference date of next release: 1.1.2016
- Issues:
 - Coverage extension
 - Consistency EBM–ERM
- Deadline for national updates: 30.6.2016

EBM v10.0 coverage extension


Complete European coverage is a mandatory Eurostat requirement!



Consistency EBM – ERM-BND

established workflow:



- Benefits:
 - Avoid additional workload of NMCAs
 - same geometry for international boundaries, national boundaries and coastlines among the products
- Challenge:
 - National data sources for EBM and ERM are sometimes different

EBM outlook

- Future of EBM depending on:
 - Willingness of EuroGeographics and its members to produce a data product
 - Sufficient number of customers/users
 - Sufficient resources for product management
- General idea for EBM:
 - Fasten production
 - Yearly update with reference date 1st January
 - Public release in late autumn
 - Create more synergies between ERM and EBM
