

Information on Open Data in Ukraine – response to the query during the extraordinary General Assembly 2020

Government of Ukraine shares open data by network service: data.gov.ua.

Documents investigate the benefits of open data for society:

- 1) The Cabinet of Ministers' decree No. 835 'On Approval of the Provision on Data Sets to be Released', (2015);
- 2) Law of Ukraine 'On Access to Public Information', (2019);
- 3) Law of Ukraine 'On National Geospatial Data Infrastructure', (2020).

Ukraine has made significant progress in publishing open data and building an ecosystem around that data to encourage its productive use. Much of this development is a result of close cooperation between government and civil society. During recent years, an unprecedented amount of public data has become open, including business and court registers and public transactions. This has resulted in efficiency gains and cost savings, new and better services, new business models and more efficient markets.

For example, cadastral parcel data, land registry data, admin. boundaries, hydrography, transport and vegetation have 4th degree of openness (URI by Tim Berners-Lee).
