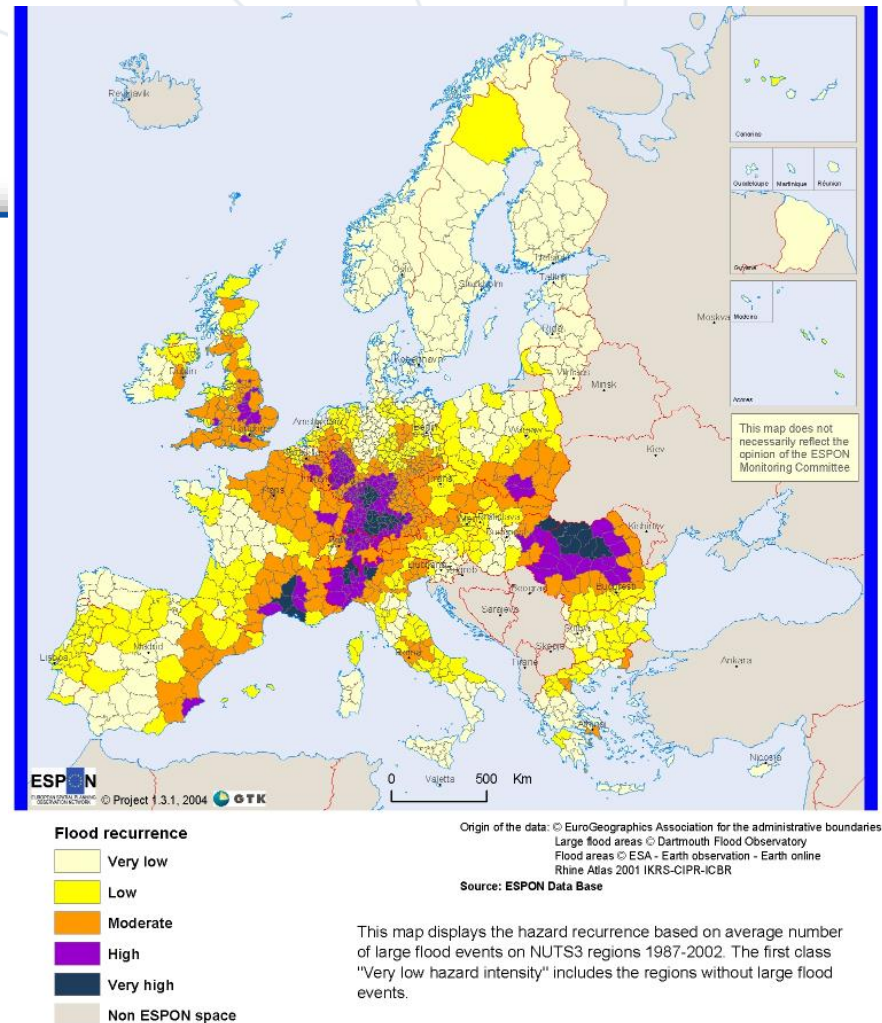

 - ★ Availability, Access, Authorization

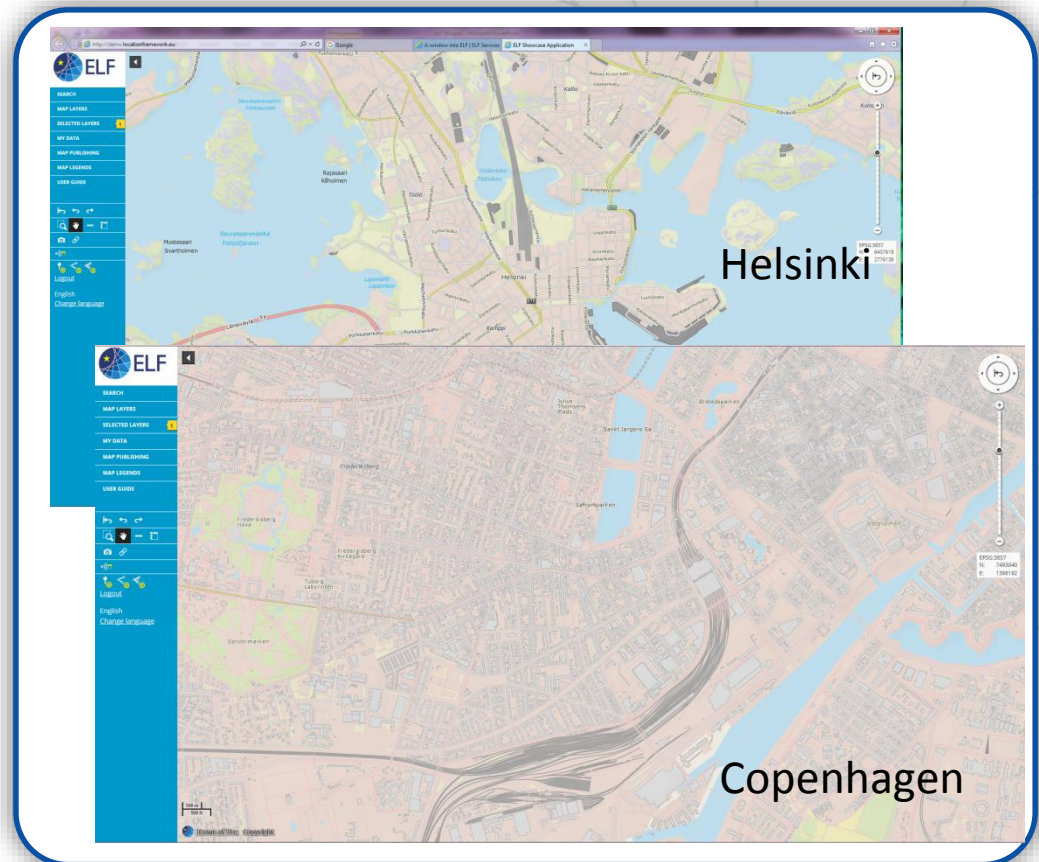

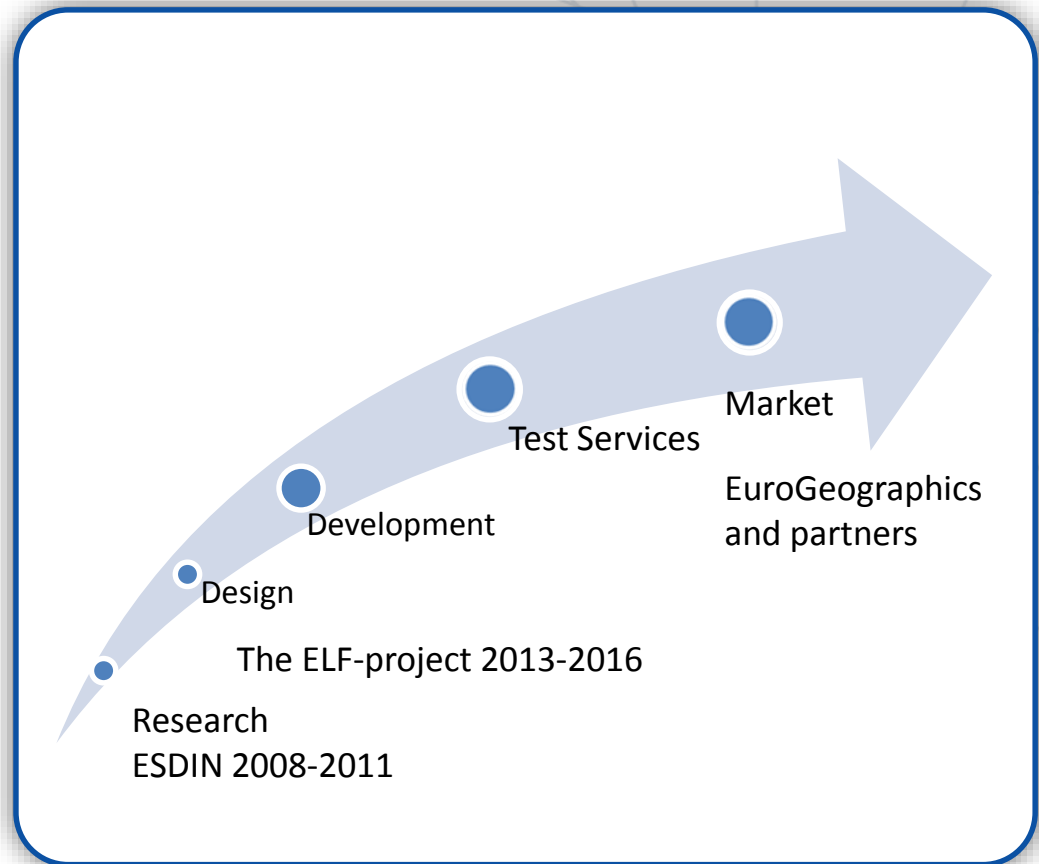

- As ELF is providing **reference data** there is a need to develop end-products/services together with partners & application developers



What ELF is not

- Currently it is not designed to sell datasets covering large areas like Europe/ country – it is providing access to these through services
- Why not datasets -> it is rather difficult to manage them, long delays in publishing, needs central production which is difficult from the European perspective
- It is not creating a portal -> we are targeting to provide real usable services to applications -> showcase application is a showcase!
- It is not dependent on ArcGIS Online/Cloud implementation – it is one commercial way to utilize ELF – other are welcome
- It is not targeted to replace Google Maps/Bing Maps -> it is choice for those needing our data, Google is welcome to utilize ELF

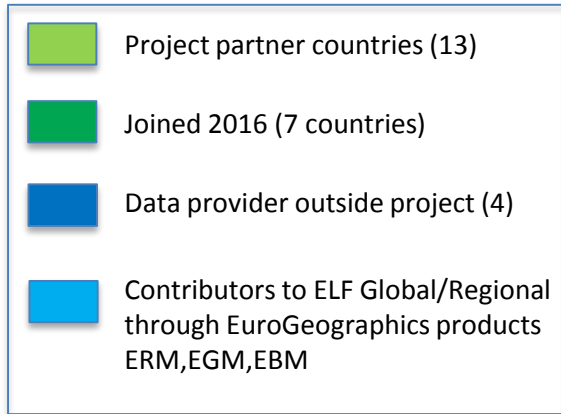
Main advancements in Year 3

ELF data providers in 2016/7

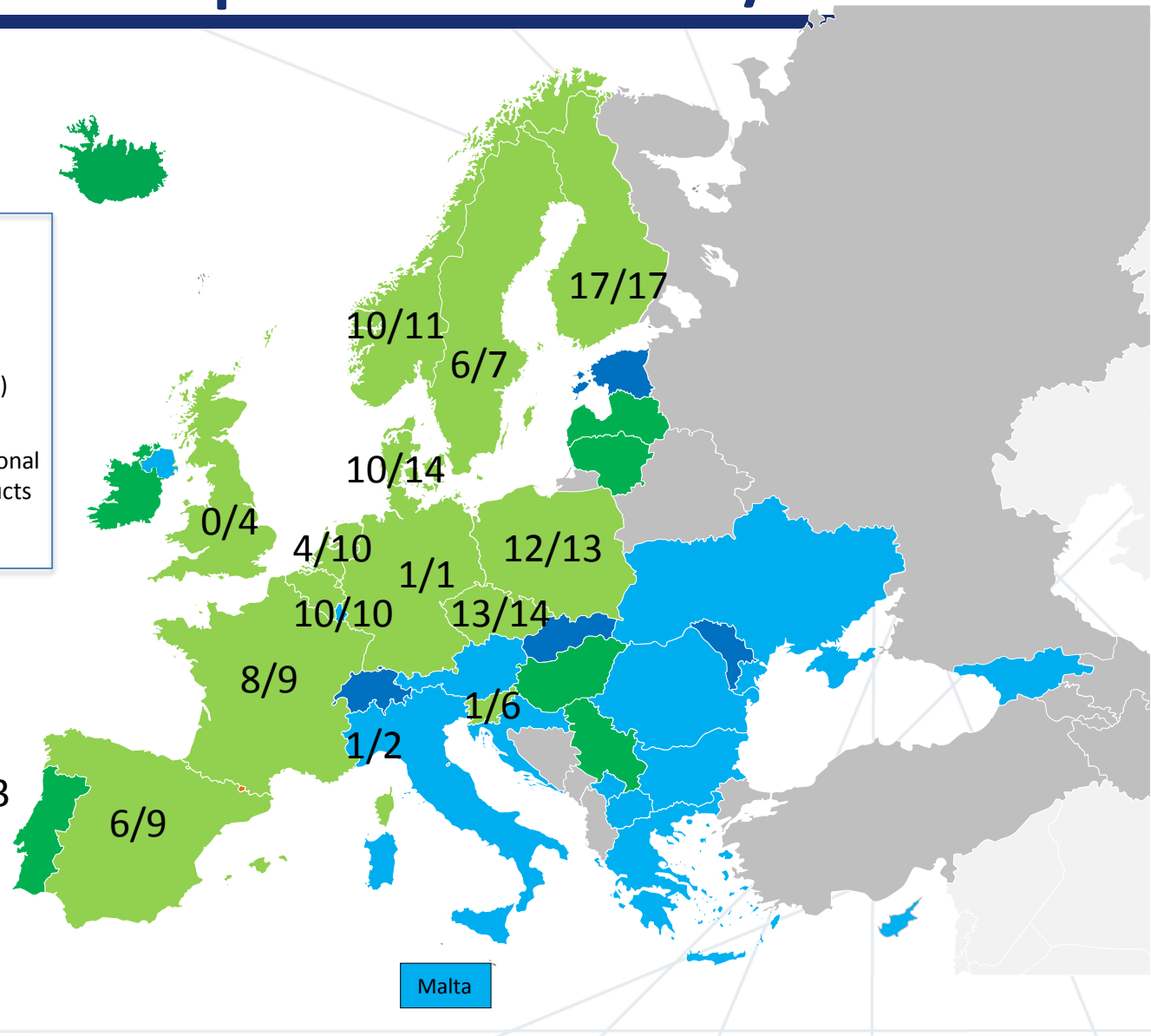
